No exclusive training in tourism is required, however experience or professional interest in the sector is required.

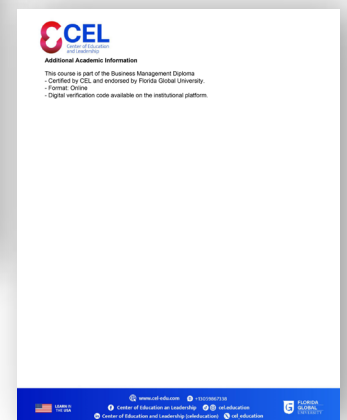
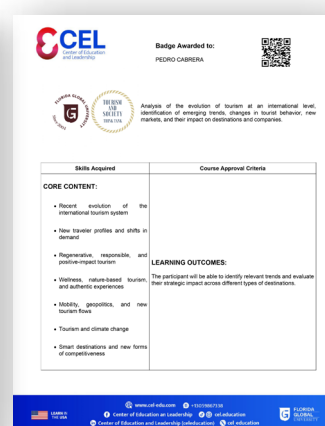
